<b>Yom Kippur*:</b>	Begins sunset Friday, September 24, ends sunset Saturday, September 25.
<b>Sukkot*:</b>	Begins sunset Wednesday, September 29, ends sunset Friday, October 1.
<b>Shemini Atzeret:</b>	Begins sunset Wednesday, October 6, ends sunset Thursday, October 7.
<b>Simchat Torah**:</b>	Begins sunset Thursday, October 7, ends sunset Friday, October 8.
<b>Hanukkah***:</b>	Begins sunset Tuesday, December 7, ends sunset Wednesday, December 15.
<b>Pesach (Passover)**:</b>	(Beginning Days) Begins sunset Saturday, April 23, ends sunset Monday, April 25. (Concluding Days) Begins sunset Friday, April 29, ends sunset Sunday, May 1.
<b>Shavuot**:</b>	Begins sunset Sunday, June 12, ends sunset Tuesday, June 14.
